My name is Julie Kaloper (the kids call me “Nurse Julie”) and I am the Seattle School District Registered Nurse assigned to Loyal Heights and North Beach.

In the school setting, I manage children with many types of health concerns; from asthma and food allergies, to cancer, autism, attention issues, diabetes, seizures, etc. I am responsible for the training, educating and supervising of the school staff so that they know what to do and how to keep our students safe. Our goal is to provide a safe environment for your child so that he/she can feel safe, secure, and thrive in the academic environment.

The first few weeks of the school year are *very* busy so I’d like to get a jump-start on some of my duties. One of the first tasks for me for the upcoming school year is to plan for students with health issues and immunization non-compliance. Please fill out the enclosed Health Registration Form (***blue form***) so I am aware of any incoming students with medical needs. Feel free to provide additional information if necessary. **Return forms to the school office as soon as possible.**

All students must be up-to-date with the state required immunizations in order to attend school. *Children who are not fully immunized may be excluded from school until they have received the necessary shots. The new law requires a physician’s signature on a Certificate of Exemption Form (COE) for any exemption requests.*

If you have questions or concerns, I work until June 24<sup>th</sup> and then I “officially” report back to school in late August for Jump Start, prep, trainings and staff education. I may be checking my email occasionally throughout the summer and the school office staff can reach me if necessary. To help make the beginning of the year less of a frenzy, please let me know if your child will need any type of medications and/or medical treatments during the school day.
